

## Preschool and Kindergarten Class:

We seem to finally be enjoying some warmer weather and we are expecting "April Showers bring May Flowers!" We have spent so much time indoors and will be excited to spend time outside. Our children strengthen growing muscles when they are climbing, running, playing ball and jumping. This month we will also be taking time to discuss all the changes around us.

Thank you dear parents for your continuous support in our class activities. The children enjoyed their Easter Lunch Party. We appreciate the time, effort and contributions given to the class.

This month we are celebrating Earth Day and in line with this, the children will learn about how to reuse, reduce and recycle. The trip to the San Diego Botanical Garden will also help the children be aware of their environment and how to protect it. The class is collecting cereal boxes (20 pcs), brown grocery bags (10 pcs), huge box (2 pcs) and clean glass/mason 16oz jars with lids (20 pcs).

In Language, some children are working on their reading skills and the others are working on building three letter words with use of movable alphabet. The children have been practicing on the proper writing of the letters and we encourage parents to let them practice at home as well. Some children are learning the upper case letters and their names. In Math, some children are working on the function of addition and reading the numbers in large quantities. Each day we are counting 1-100 and some have mastered counting in tens along with learning the symbols. In Culture and Science, we are learning about the animals and their young, the different life cycles and the changes of the seasons. Our artist for the month is Georges Seurat and the composer is Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky. Our role model for this month is Queen Elizabeth II and learn about the value of strong leadership. Friday is our "Show and Tell" day, and we encourage the children to bring something that they would like to share and talk about in class (photo, memorabilia, souvenirs from trips, book..) Be reminded to take your child's water bottle home to be washed and refilled. Check your child's folder and cubby for an extra set of clean clothing. Mornings can still be chilly outside and your child will need a jacket/sweater.
