Preschool Class:

This month we will be celebrating Valentine's Day. Children will be doing some fun artwork and making gifts. Children have made good progress in all areas of Montessori and the use of materials. Preschool and Kindergarten Class:

It's the month of hearts and full of love. We can just see hearts, roses, plush toys, chocolates and presents everywhere. We have a few events to celebrate in this month of February—Valentine's Day, Chinese New Year and Presidents' Day.

The children continue enhancing their skills by identifying the simple phonetic sounds of the alphabet; first, middle and the last sound of a word. Some children who have mastered the simple phonetic sounds have moved to the next level while others are mastering how to form three-letter words, four-letter words and sentences with the aid of the movable alphabet. Some children are already reading words, sentences and books. Everyone is working hard to improve their skills in Mathematics and Language. We encourage the children to practice counting at home especially those who are learning the tens (10, 20...90), teens (11, 12,...19) and numbers between the tens (50, 51, 52, 53....60). Practice at home especially in writing is strongly encouraged. Coloring pages help in improving their writing skills and fine hand movement. They are concentrating with morning and afternoon. Afternoon time is Montessori work in allotted for art projects and preparing for the upcoming celebrations.

We will be talking about the presidents of our country and their accomplishments. The role model of this month is George Washington and the value is bravery. Joseph Haydn is the composer and Georgia O'Keeffe is the artist for this month.

We will have a Valentine Lunch Party for the children on February 14 and we will be collecting \$7 for your child's class lunch party.

Date Night is here! Hooooray!! Parents' Night Out is on February 15 from 6pm-10pm. Don't forget to sign up!

Please check your child's cubby weekly and bring extra underwear, socks and clothing which are appropriate for the season. Check the monthly snack sign up in the bulletin board.
