Preschool and Kindergarten Class:

It's the month of hearts and full of love. We can just see hearts, roses, plush toys, chocolates and presents everywhere. We have a quite a few events to celebrate in this month of February—Mardi Gras, Valentine's Day, Chinese New Year and Presidents' Day.

The children continue enhancing their skills by identifying the simple phonetic sounds of the alphabet; first and the last sound of a word. Some children who have mastered the simple phonetic sounds have moved to the next level while others are mastering how to form three-letter words, four-letter words and sentences with the aid of the movable alphabet. The children are working hard to improve their skills in math and language. We encourage the children to practice counting at home especially those who are learning the tens (10, 20...90) and teens (11, 12,...19). Afternoon time is allotted for art projects and preparing for the upcoming celebrations. We will be talking about the presidents of our country and their accomplishments. George Handel is the composer and Georgia O'Keeffe is the artist for this month. We will have a Valentine Lunch Party for the children on February 14 and a sign up list will be posted on the attendance clipboard.

Please check your child's cubby weekly and bring extra underwear, socks and clothing which are appropriate for the season. Check the monthly snack sign up in the bulletin board. Report cards are ready and placed inside your child's folder. Sign and return the cards. Thank you for your continuous support in all our class activities.

Preschool Prep Class:

Even though February is the shortest month of the year we have much going on! It is the international month of friendship, which we will honor with discussions, stories, and encouragement on how to show love to families and friends. We have a celebration planned for Valentine's Day and we encourage your child to bring valentine's treats to share with their classmates. Along with Valentine's Day there will be Chinese New Year and Presidents' Day. We all are so excited.

Math: This month many of our math activities will be focused on patterning as well as practicing our counting skills using Montessori materials

Language Some children have mastered the vowels and are focusing on consonants, while others are still working on it. In Botany, they are so excited to learn parts of the tree with all the puzzles and charts.
