


Infant & Toddler Class:


Preschool Prep Class:

Preschool and Kindergarten Class:

Spring is finally here! It's hard to believe the school year is almost over! As we begin the month of April, we hope we will all be able to enjoy a warmer weather and many beautiful spring days but of course hoping the some rainy days since our area is currently in a drought state. As part of our Earth day celebration, we are also incorporating conscious awareness for **WATER CONSERVATION** and keeping our slogan to **REDUSE-REUSE-RECYCLE**.

This month, we will be talking about spring and how things are changing outside. The children will continue on learning about the different seasons and the changes. Each child will do some planting of seeds in potting soil and will watch our plant begin to grow.
